Suggested Materials List

One of our main goals this year is preparing the students for the years of schooling ahead. With this in mind, it is of paramount importance that your child is organized and ready to learn. This includes maintaining adequate materials at home as well as at school. Here is a list of items that will help them have a successful year! Items should be kept at home until they are needed at school as we don't have room to keep the extra supplies. This list is optional and it is not mandatory that each student have all items. It is merely a suggestion for students as we continue to face budgetary constraints.

Sturdy backpack

One 2" 3-ring binder (most important!) to organize school work, **(Must keep in backpack)**

1 pack of subject dividers with pockets (can use hole-punched folders)

Zipper bag pencil case **(to go inside the binder)**

1 large plastic pencil box **(for top of their desk to hold misc. supplies).**

2 spiral notebooks - one red, one black **(bring to school for class use-1 subject, 70 sheets or more)**

A few packs of 3x5 ruled index cards for notes (I suggest 100 cards in total)

1 pack of #2 Ticonderoga pencils **(2 in your pencil box, the rest at home)**

2 fine point Sharpies **(1 in your pencil box, 1 for home)**

2 Erasable black pens **(1 in your pencil box, 1 for home)**

2 Erasable red pens **(1 in your pencil box, 1 for home)**

2 highlighters **(1 in your pencil box, 1 for home)**

2 Staedtler White Plastic Erasers **(1 in your pencil box, 1 for home)**

1 pair of children's scissors **(to be kept in pencil box)**

1 pack of Expo Dry Erase markers **(2 in your pencil box and keep extra's at home)**

1 Old sock to be used as a white board eraser **(to be kept in pencil box)**

1 large glue stick **(bring to school for class use)**

1 pack of Colored markers **(bring to school for class use)**

1 pack of colored pencils **(bring to school for class use)**

1 ream of white copy paper **(bring to school for class use)**

One pack of 2x3 inch Post-it notes **(bring to school for class use)**

2 packs of wide ruled notebook paper **(bring to school for class use)**

2 boxes of Kleenex **(bring to school for class use)**

Once again, we would like to stress the importance of not bringing items to the class that will take away from the learning taking place. PLEASE do not purchase materials with logos or commercial content as they have a tendency to go missing. PLAIN IS BETTER! Thank you again for helping your child get off to a good start!
